

How much does a public transportation ticket cost?

Single ticket from the driver – EUR 1

Vilniečio card – EUR 1.50

30 min. ticket – EUR 0.65

60 min. ticket – EUR 0.90

1- day ticket – EUR 5.00

3-day ticket – EUR 8.00

5-day ticket – EUR 12.00

10-day ticket – EUR 15.00

The prices are quoted without concessions. For special rates applicable to students, pensioners and disabled, enquire at ticket outlets or visit Vilnius public transportation website at: www.vilniustransport.lt.

Where to get a public transportation ticket?

You may buy a single ticket from the driver. Its price without a discount is EUR 1. The ticket will be valid up to the last stop of the route. If you plan spending more time in Vilnius, we recommend acquiring Vilniečio Card and topping it up with e-tickets or money. Vilniečio Card, which costs EUR 15, is available at the Narvesen store located in the airport (Arrival A or Departure), in the city – in all the venues marked by sign Vilniečio Card.

By taking bus 88 or 3G, you will reach the city centre in about 20 minutes.

How often does the public transportation run?

4 buses and 1 night bus run from/to Vilnius airport. Bus 3G runs every 10 minutes. Buses 1, 2 and 88 run every 20-30 minutes. Night bus 88N runs on the route Airport–Center–Europa square from 10:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

What transport may I take to the airport or to the city?

You may arrive to Vilnius airport and leave by several ways: by city buses, TOKS van, train, taxi and car.

City buses:

- No.1 Airport – Station
- No.2 Airport – Vikingai – Liepkalnio St. - Station
- No.88 Airport – Center – Europa square
- No.88N Airport – Center – Europa square (night bus)
- No.3G Airport – Center – Fabijoniškės
- You may find city bus timetables on the website of Vilnius public transportation at www.stops.lt, and on the screens in the Arrival Terminal of Vilnius Airport and the airport bus stop.

You may acquire a ticket from the Narvesen newsstand located in the airport arrival lounge or from the bus driver. Ticket price – EUR 1. For special rates applicable to students, pensioners and disabled, enquire at ticket outlets or visit the website of Vilnius public transportation at: www.vilniustransport.lt.

TOKS vans stand in the parking lot at the exit from the Arrival lounge and they run on the routes Airport – Station, Station – Airport. You may acquire a ticket from the van driver. One ticket price – EUR 1. No special rates are applied.

Train: you may arrive to the airport or leave by train. The timetable is available here: www.litrail.lt. You will find a train stop following the indications. You may acquire a ticket in the train. Ticket price – EUR 0.70.

Taxi: for more information on taxi recommended by Vilnius Airport, its prices and operation procedure click here: www.vilnius-airport.lt. After using taxi services, always ask for a receipt for the services rendered!

Car: information on how to arrive to the airport by car is available on our website at: www.vno.lt.

IMPORTANT!

When going to the airport, evaluate the situation of transport flows on the city roads and properly plan the time in order not to be late for your flight. We recommend coming to Vilnius Airport 2 hours before a flight.
